


There can be a lot of confusion about Ireland. The Republic of Ireland is a country in and of itself. It is not part of the United Kingdom, so most UK visas will not let you fly into Dublin.

Also, just to confuse matters more, Ireland is part of the European Union (EU), but is not part of the common Schengen Area. So a visa, for example, for Italy or France will not allow you to enter Ireland.

However, if for those who are from a country where a visa is required, it is certainly possible to apply for a visa to attend the Congress. Anyone who does needs a visa should start an application process as soon as possible.
